Exploring once more this noble and delicate material

'La Porcelaine de Limoges' was born from the casual discovery of a kaolin deposit around Limoges in 1765. It opened the way to new expression fields. This easy to mould material rapidly gained a reputation for excellence. Each complex and unique item is real goldsmith work and entirely handmade.

The industrial revolution brought its lot of innovations and modernity which enabled porcelain manufactures to open to international markets. Reserved to Parisian elite in the first place, Limoges Porcelain was renewed; output was improved while preserving an unequalled level of quality and requirement.

'La Porcelaine de Limoges' obviously went a few setbacks after the two world wars but it always recovered thanks to its manufactures which were aware of the fact that design is an innovation motor and generates value. In the 50s, they were updated notably through designers like Raymond Loewy, Roger Tallon, Marc Held, Andrée Putman...

Nevertheless, since the 80s, consumer habits have evolved and popularity has decreased... To be successful again Limoges Porcelain needs to renew itself one more time. That is what we are starting to do with ARTORIA Manufacture in developing new porcelain items meant for spirit drinks.

Fine and translucent ceramics,

PORCELAIN OWES ITS PHYSICAL PROPERTIES TO ITS UNIQUE COMPONENTS. THREE NATURAL ROCKS ARE THUS ASSEMBLED, DILUTED IN WATER, GROUND, SIFTED AND FILTERED TO MAKE A MORE OR LESS LIQUID PASTE.



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- Kaolin

It accounts for 50% of the composition of Limoges Porcelain. It gives Limoges Porcelain its basic structure and its unique whiteness.

WHITENESS TRANSLUCENCY SONORITY PERMEABILITY

Quartz

It accounts for 1/4 of the composition; it brings hardness and translucency.

Feldspath


It accounts for 1/4 of the composition. Its use is more technical than aesthetical: It acts as a melting agent and enables vitrification.



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01. Sketching // From an idea or a concept #LineaDesigners come up with new carafe and bottle standards in the world of spirit drinks.



02. Mould and model creation // From 3D sketching, #Artoria modelling makes a plaster volume to obtain the first mould and the core that will be used for making production moulds.



03. Pouring // It consists in pouring the porcelain paste, into a plaster mould to make hollow Items. Once the wanted thickness has been reached, the mould is overturned to empty the paste surplus. The item must harden before demoulding.



04. Finishing // It enables to remove the «seams» on the items caused by the splitting of the mould and to eliminate any other kind of flaws. A steel blade and then mild abrasive are used to polish the object. A wet paintbrush and a sponge are then used for the finishing touch.



05. Drying // It is the time during which the room is stored in the restroom to evacuate naturally its moisture.



06. Initial firing // The shaped, finished and dried items undergo a first 980° firing. It is called initial firing. It enables to obtain items that cannot be diluted, are more mechanically resistant with a maximal porosity.



07. Enamelling // Porcelain enamel is feldspar and limestone glass. It is a polish that is baked at the same temperature as the paste it lies on. The Item is then plunged into an enamel bath.

08. High firing // At 1400°C, it vitrifies the paste and the enamel to make the porcelain whiter, more solid and translucent. The paste is brought to a partial fusion and the enamel to a total fusion.



09. Decoration of the items // Hand painted depending on the complexity of the components. In other cases a chromo (decalcomania) is applied by hand.

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


